:: Project Overview:

In the last 6 years the Nations Online Project has been developed into an internationally recognized internet portal in the fields of information on geography, culture, history and politics of almost all countries of the world.

Today more than 200,000 Internet users visit the project's site every month. The purpose of the portal is to guide users to "first hand" information of the world's countries and nations.

Organized geographically the project offers beside basic information, an extensive collection of evaluated links to internet sites of the various nations.

Included are only sites which we have visited, with the intention to provide the user with comprehensive, in-depth documentation or background information. The links have a brief description of each site.

We make no claims for completeness and welcome user suggestions for additions.

Our objective is to provide visitors with a broad range of information so they will have the possibility to get a comprehensive impression about a nation and its people.

Beyond that the project is a statment for democracy, tolerance and freedom of speech.

On our web site you will find up-to-date information on 200 states and countries.

___ statistics:

Nations Online Project has been online since the end of September 1998, with a contstantly growing number of daily visitors.

At the end of 2000 about 10 000 users visited each month, In May 2004 the site has served 191 000 sessions, 498 000 page views to 120 000 unique visitors.

University Libraries Ohio University


A gateway site to information on all countries, with links to government pages, media sites, country guides, etc. Also includes international organizations and other related information.
